

The Year 6 theme until half term is

'Circle of Life'

This covers many areas of the curriculum as shown

English - During English lessons, class reader time and guided reading sessions, we will be reading stories, information books and watching video clips about the science related topic of animals including humans and evolution and inheritance. Each class has borrowed a box of books from the Library so that we can dip into them whenever we wish!

These materials will also be used to aid write a non-chronological report based on an animal. We will also produce a descriptive narrative using an animation called 'The Piano'.

Mathematics - We will be having regular 'I Can Do Maths' sessions, as well as weekly Two Minute Mental Maths Challenges.

Our Maths this half term will cover: negative values, prime numbers, factors and multiples, multiplying and dividing values using formal written methods, and working with fractions, decimals and percentages. We will also be covering percentages, volume, solving problems involving position and direction and measure.



Science - As part of our science work, we will be focusing on animals including humans and evolution and inheritance. Therefore we will look at the bodies circulatory system, how to keep our bodies health though diet and exercise. Further to this, we will also be learning about how animals and humans evolved, the process of inheritance and how animals adapt to different environments.

Art - We will be learning how to create Movement. During this work we will study various artists work and learn how to make careful observations of both the body and facial expressions. We will also learn different sketching techniques, how to produce a montage and also how to use printing to create the impression of movement.

Computing - We will refine our websites that we created last half-term.

RE - Our focus is to explore harmlessness, community and grace in differing religions.

French - We will be learning through oral and written sessions the French vocabulary for buying food items and activities at parties.

Music - We will be learning songs for our Easter Church Service

After lunch on a Wednesday Year 6 pupils will be involved in an afternoon of activities designed to enrich the curriculum. Each class will take turns at all activities over the course of the year, these will include professional sports coaching, art P.E. and Life skills through the Change for Life program.
