

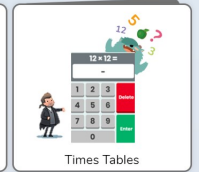
Strike while the iron is hot!

What is good about it, what skills do they need?

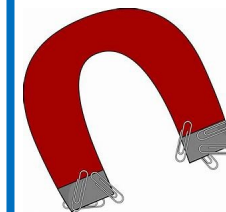
Draw a sketch of a traditional Iron Age man or woman.
